# The way of incense Koh-do workshop

We organize accessible programs that offer  
foreign visitors and others the opportunity  
to gain authentic first-hand experience  
of traditional culture and performing arts.

Koh-do (traditional Japanese incense) is an art form that developed in Kyoto more than 500 years ago. The art form, which values Zen teachings, is performed in the mental realm by appreciating the natural fragrance of an aromatic tree called Agarwood.

The Shino Incense School has passed down the teachings of its founder, Shino Soshin, for twenty generations, and the School has spread beyond Japan as well. There are now places to study its teachings in Paris, Boston, Beijing, etc.

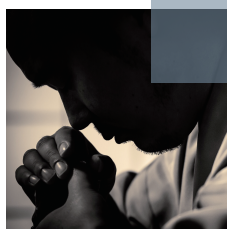

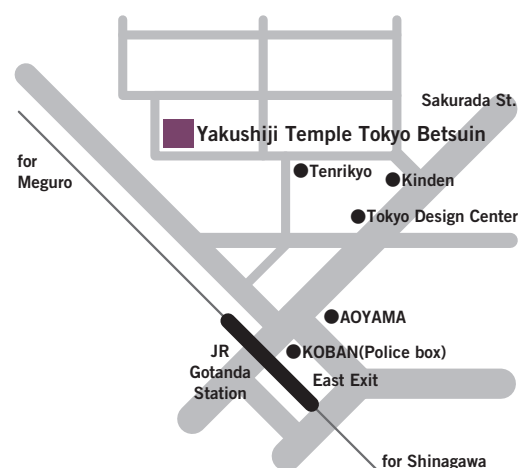
