Kabuki is one of Japanese representative traditional art of entertainment, integrating elements of music, dance, and acting. It is said to have been created in Kyoto around 1600. Since then, it has continued to pass down its traditions while incorporating modernity, continuing to exist as a form of the theater which has fascinated people for more than 400 years.

In 2005, it was registered as UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage.
